



## The Muse

**Purpose:** Activities at Camporama 2016 that will promote boys to use Fine Arts (one of the 5 things/methods) that interest boys.

**Activities:**

- **Main Stage** – Show off the talents that God has given to you!
  - Open Mic (sign up required) - Bring your group to perform during an Open Mic Session. Performances may include:
    - Group Performances such as Christian Band, Worship Team, Human Videos & Dramas
    - Solo Performances such as Instrumentals, Vocals, Drama & Human Video SolosAll performances should follow the rules listed in the [2016 Fine Arts Festival Rule Book](#). Prizes will be given to the top in each category. Drum Set, Keyboard, Guitar & Bass Amps will be provided. Please bring any other equipment you might need.
  - Lip Sync Battle (bring your own device) – Whenever performances are not taking place on the Main Stage, bring your favorite Christian song or rap on your music device and battle head-to-head against your best friends. Who is the best Lip Sync Artist?
- **Fine Arts** – Has God given you the talent of Art or Writing?
  - *Camporama Fine Arts Exhibit* - Submit your entries to be put on display at The Muse! Submissions may include:
    - Art submissions such as Graphic Design, Photography, T-Shirt Design, and Visual Art
    - Writing submissions such as Book Chapter, Children’s Literature, First Person Essay, Flash Fiction, and PoetryAll performances should follow the rules listed in the [2016 Fine Arts Festival Rule Book](#). Items may be dropped off at The Muse on Monday. Prizes will be given to the top in each category.

- **Bible Quiz Challenge** – “I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.” Psalms 119:11. Earn points for your Team by competing in the Bible Quiz Challenge. A chapter of the bible for the quizzing will be announced at on site registration. Additional points can be earned by memorizing the chapter.
- **Flag Design Station** – A centralized area where the team flag can be worked on throughout the day while going from activity to activity. Flags will be judged on Wednesday at the Group Games.
