# Demonstrators Information and Contract Provision

## Demonstrators

Demonstrators could include Royal Rangers district, regional, and national leaders or Royal Rangers boys.

## Location

Camp will be held at Camp Eagle Rock, 28879 FR 1162, Eagle Rock, MO. Exhibit location will be communicated to exhibitors at registration. All demonstrators must check in at registration.

## Due Date

May 18, 2020. Spaces will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

## Booth Specifications

To be determined by the demonstrator and a national representative. Royal Rangers will assign location of booth space. This is an outdoor event. Power and water are not available to booth spaces.

## Insurance

Each demonstrator must submit proof of liability insurance (minimum \$1,000,000). This is not applicable if you do not have a display and are not selling product. ## Qualifications

The purpose of the demonstration is to acquaint our Royal Rangers with the skill and products you offer that will benefit and enhance their experience. It is not to sale product. We ask that you limit your sales to no more than \$3000. You should consider carefully this policy when making application.

## Hours of operation

Demonstration times will be scheduled with the Royal Rangers national office and the FCF national coordinator. You may arrive before and stay after operation hours for 30 minutes to set up and clean up.

## Set Up and Take Down

Set up: July 17-18, 2020, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Take down: July 24, 2020, 8:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.

## Policies

No demonstrator shall assign, sublet, or apportion the whole or any part of the space allotted for any goods other than those manufactured by the demonstrator.

## Vehicle Policy

Vehicles are only allowed in activity area on set up and take down dates and times. All other times vehicles must be parked in assigned parking area. Tram service is available from parking area to activity area July 19-24, 2020.
